## THE HARVEST IS PLENTIFUL, BUT THE WORKERS ARE FEW MANY

*Jesus was going through all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every disease and every sickness. Seeing the crowds, He felt compassion for them, because they were distressed and downcast, like sheep without a shepherd. Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Therefore, plead with the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into His harvest." (Matthew 9:35–38)*

Cambodia Christian Ministries (CCM) is committed to following in the footsteps of Jesus. Jesus helped meet the physical needs and especially the spiritual needs of the people. CCM continues the mission of Jesus as we always bring doctors and Bible teachers to provide both physical and spiritual healing to the precious people in the remote villages of Cambodia. The Lord has led us to make "Jesus footprints" in 23 of the 25 provinces over the past several years as thousands have been physically and spiritually healed.

- Kea and Tra: 2015 & 2016 CBS graduates who serve as interpreters in Cambodia Bible School.
- Cambodia Bible School (CBS) students and graduates. Some are students at the university in Phnom Penh on weekends. During the week they tutor Jesus Children in math, science, and other school subjects as well as Bible study. Two of the female university students are Jesus Children who have graduated from high school and are furthering their education.
- Fulltime orphanage workers: SaKim, Chouen, and Sreynit.
- Reagan Ashley: recently finished his two-year stint with the Peace Corps in Cambodia and has moved to CCM to teach English and Bible to our Jesus Children.
- Numerous house-parents for the Jesus Children.

The prayers of many CCM supporter are being answered as Sokhom has a great number of faithful Christians who labor in the harvest.

New converts take the Lord's Supper for the first time after being baptized. Everyone celebrated with a coconut fellowship, enjoying fresh coconuts from the CCM farm.

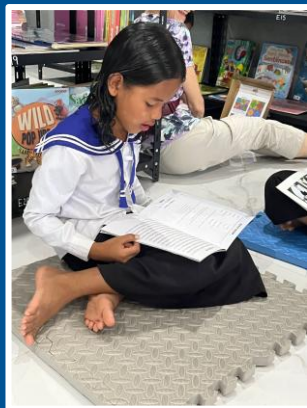
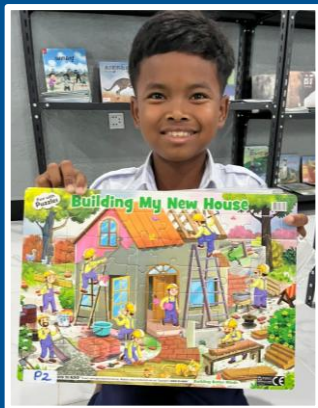
# EDUCATIONAL HARVEST



These eight young people are students or graduates of CBS. They take university classes in Phnom Penh on the weekends. On weekday afternoons and evenings they tutor Jesus' Children of all ages in math, reading, science, etc. Two of these tutors are Jesus' Children high school graduates now attending university.



Since Cambodia public education is only half day, our Jesus Children will excel as a result of the tutoring. Many will become doctors, nurses, engineers, etc. and will influence the spiritual landscape of Cambodia.



Kevin Carson is a retired educator and school administrator. He helped build our Christian School library. Generous Christians donated funds for the purchase of over 2,000 books for the library.

In the last couple of years Sokhom has begun conducting mini leader care seminars for church leaders. Sokhom does all of the teaching and one or two doctors accompany him offering medical treatment. These house church leaders will go back to their villages and share the Good News of Jesus Christ. A number of them are former enemy Pol Pot soldiers and now they are fellow soldiers for Jesus Christ.
